Quality Education & Public Library:

This year has been transformative for our organization as we spearheaded various education development activities aimed at empowering communities and fostering lifelong learning. Our initiatives have reached diverse populations, emphasizing inclusivity and quality education. Below is a summary of our key activities and achievements:

We established 3 new Community Learning Centers in underserved areas, providing access to educational resources and a conducive learning environment for over 1,000 students.

Teacher Training Programs:

Conducted comprehensive training sessions for **50** teachers, focusing on modern pedagogical techniques, digital literacy, and inclusive education practices.

Partnered with educational experts to develop a curriculum that enhances teachers' skills and improves student engagement and outcomes.

Scholarship Programs:

After-School Tutoring:

Support Services:


Provided necessary educational materials, including books, stationery, and uniforms, to support the learning process.

Awareness against Child labor & Child marriage

This year, our NGO's dedicated team members conducted an impactful awareness campaign against child labor and child marriage, focusing particularly on the slum areas of Delhi. Understanding the prevalence of these issues in underprivileged communities, our campaign aimed to educate and empower residents to protect children's rights and ensure their well-being.

Awareness Drives:

Organized door-to-door visits in slum areas to engage with families and educate them about the legal and social implications of child labor and child marriage.

Held community meetings, workshops, and interactive sessions to discuss the harmful effects of these practices on children's physical, mental, and emotional health.

Educational Sessions:

National Festivals Celebration with children:

This year, our organization placed a strong emphasis on cultural education by celebrating every national festival with our students. These celebrations aimed to foster a sense of unity, cultural awareness, and community spirit among the students. Here is a summary of our key activities and achievements in this regard:

Republic Day Celebration:

Organized a grand celebration involving flag hoisting, a parade, and cultural performances by students.

Conducted essay writing and drawing competitions on the theme of patriotism, with winners awarded certificates and prizes.

Independence Day Celebration:

Marked the occasion with flag hoisting, a patriotic speech by a guest speaker, and a series of cultural performances including songs and dances.

Healthcare Program (checkup & medicine dist.)

Our women's team organized an awareness camp focusing on mother and child healthcare, emphasizing the importance of proper care for pregnant women and newborn children. Recognizing the critical need for education and support in these areas, our team aimed to provide valuable information and resources to improve health outcomes for mothers and children in our community.

Conducted workshops on prenatal and postnatal care, highlighting the importance of regular medical check-ups, proper nutrition, and healthy lifestyle practices for pregnant women. Provided information on the stages of pregnancy, warning signs of complications, and the importance of timely medical intervention.

Organized sessions on newborn care, covering topics such as breastfeeding, immunization, hygiene, and recognizing signs of illness in infants. Emphasized the importance of exclusive breastfeeding for the first six months and the introduction of complementary foods thereafter.

Program for Prevention of Early age pregnancy

This year, the dedicated women team members of our NGO organized an impactful awareness program focused on the prevention of early age pregnancy. Through this awareness program, our NGO has made significant strides in preventing early age pregnancies and promoting the health and well-being of young women in our community.

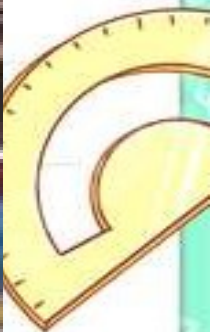


Study kits distribution to Poor students -

English Spoken classes for Youth
